Amendments to Rules & Regulations -July 2012

**Delete** from Rules & Regulations July 2012 p6

1. Palominos exhibiting at Sydney Royal, Canberra Royal or Bathurst Royal should be shown in led classes with free flowing manes and tails and no false tails.
2. It is preferred that all members show under these conditions at all shows in palomino classes.
3. The wearing of false tails in all palomino classes is unacceptable.

**Replace** the above with

4. Palominos competing at open shows, agricultural shows, breed shows and all Royals shows in led and ridden classes may be shown with manes that are plaited, free flowing or hogged without bias.
5. Palominos competing at open shows, agricultural shows, breed shows and all Royals shows in led and ridden classes may be shown with tails that are plaited, clipped or free flowing without bias. False tails may be worn in all palomino classes with the exception of Mane and Tail classes.
6. The rules specified in a show's schedule shall take precedence over the NSW Palomino Society's rules.

**Unchanged** rules p6

7. It is a condition of entry that at the Society's State Championship Show that all horses must be shown with free flowing manes and tails in all classes on the day.
8. The wearing of false tails in all palomino *and cremello/perlino* classes is unacceptable at the Society's State Championship Show in all classes. (wording in italics- additional to existing rule)
9. If a member competes in a led class with his/her palomino plaited, it is the judge's privilege to ask that a number of plaits be undone for the inspection of the mane for the correct judging of the class. (This rule refers to shows other than the State Show)

Additional rule to add to point 7.

10. However, if a palomino, cremello or perlino has a hogged mane then it may be shown at the Society's State Championship in conformation (led) classes and ridden classes. Horses with hogged manes may not enter Best Presented and Mane & Tail classes on the day.
